(12) Start

· To Start Area

The start area for MA, WA, M35A, OMA, and OWA classes is a 15-minute walk from the event site, marked with blue tape guidance.

All **other classes** start from an area that is a 5-minute walk from the event site, marked with **yellow** tape guidance.

· Before Starting

- 1. Insert your SI Card into the **clear station**, then the **check station**.
- 2. Confirm the SI Card is working by inserting it into the **test station** and checking for a sound.
- 3. If you are late, please follow the instructions of the start area staff. In this case, your race time will, in principle, be recorded from your original start time.

· Start Procedure

- Enter the start slot **3 minutes before** your designated start time.
- 2 minutes before, move to the next slot and pick up the control description (within 150 x 60 mm).
- 1 minute before, proceed to the final start position, take your class map, and place it on the ground.
 - Start timing begins at the start signal.
 - Take your map and follow the **red and white** tape guidance to the start flag.

(13) During race

- The maximum running time is 90 minutes.
- There will be one refreshment point only for the MA, WA, M35A, OMA, and OWA classes.
- Follow the road traffic laws and be safe.
- Shoes with studs are not prohibited, but please be careful not to damage the wooden paths in the terrain.

(14) Finish

• Follow the **red and white** tape guidance from the final control to the finish.

- Timekeeping is completed by punching SI Card into the finish station.
- Your race time will be processed at the Event Centre.
- If you use a **rental SI Card**, make sure to **return it after reading**.
